

Rubena Kousar's Story

"My name is Rubena Kousar. My husband and I are polio patients, living in someone else's accommodation for a long time without a place of our own. Due to his illness, my husband cannot work regularly, and no one offers him a job. We have a little daughter who, at the age of 2-3, broke her jaw in an accident and couldn't have a full meal until she was 15. We struggled to have food on our table and take care of our five children. Thanks to Baseer Welfare International, my daughter received treatment and can now eat properly. They also provide us with monthly groceries and a brand-new fridge, which is a blessing during the

heat."

Abdur Rauf's Story

"My name is Abdur Rauf. I used to live in a village near the Indian border, where regular armed shootings would occur.

Due to this, I injured my leg and became disabled. I then migrated to Islamgarh, Azad Kashmir. I have nine children, four of whom are completely disabled. Because of my responsibilities at home and my disability, I could not earn regularly. We had no permanent shelter and lived temporarily in different places. Baseer Welfare provided us with



monthly groceries and, most importantly, a house in Islamgarh. May Allah reward them."

Shabina's Story

"My name is Shabina. We live in Mangla, Azad Kashmir. We are five siblings, and our father is a single parent. Due to his illness, he cannot work. We don't have enough food at home, and we lack furniture. Our poverty prevented us from continuing our studies. Thanks to Baseer Welfare International, we now receive regular groceries and at least have a meal in the evening."
